

CHECKOUT POLICIES

Nampa Public Library and members of the LYNX! Consortium of libraries gives you the opportunity to borrow over 460,000 titles! Whether you're looking for books, magazines, music, movies, or the latest bestseller, chances are you can get it!

You may borrow items provided you do not have fines/fees of \$10 or more, or a charge for a damaged item. Please be considerate of other customers and refrain from borrowing all items on a given topic. Also, be sure to check items for damage before checking them out, and report any damage to the clerk helping you.

BORROWING PERIODS & LIMITS PER CARD:

- BOOKS—3 Weeks
- NEW BOOKS—2 Weeks
- HOT TITLES (*Limit 3*)—2 Weeks
- MAGAZINES (*Limit 5*)—3 Weeks
- AUDIOBOOKS (*Limit 5*)—3 Weeks
- PLAYAWAYS (*Limit 3*)—3 Weeks
- CD'S (*Limit 10*)—3 Weeks
- NONFICTION MOVIES—3 Weeks
- MOVIES (*Limit 5*)—1 Week
- KITS (*Limit 5*)—3 Weeks

RENEWALS: You may renew most items once (except Hot Titles, New Books, Playaways, and Magazines) *if no other customer has a hold on that item*. Items may be renewed in person, over the phone, online, or through Telecirc at 384-4450.

HOLDS: If an item is checked out, or if you would like to get an item from a LYNX! Library (*except Twin Falls, Hailey and Mt. Home*) you can place a hold on that item. Holds also may be placed at the library, over the phone, or online.

AUDIOVISUAL MATERIALS

To check out movies, customers must have a valid library card with appropriate clearance; those under 18 must have a parent/guardian grant permission. Once an account is cleared for movie check out, the library places no restrictions on the choice of movies.

Handle all audiovisual items with care! Protect them from extreme heat and cold, and rewind all cassettes and videos.

By choosing to borrow audiovisual materials, you agree to abide by Federal copyright laws. Specifically, you agree not to copy, duplicate, broadcast or telecast on commercial, educational, closed circuit, pay, or community radio or TV any audiovisual materials you borrow from the Nampa Public Library.

Further, Nampa Public Library is not liable for damages incurred from use of library items. Be aware that some customers have not been able to use audiotapes in their vehicle players because of the labels we affix to them during processing.
